The board met on 18 March 2020 to discuss the business of the school. The key topic of discussion was the schools response to Covid-19 and the implications for continued delivery of education to the students.

COVID-19

This is a fluid situation, and all information is changing on a daily basis.

At this stage, the school will only close if: The Government orders schools to shut or if a student, parent or staff member tests positive to Covid-19.

Otherwise, the school will remain open. Plans are in place should this change.

Hygiene practices are being reinforced with the students multiple times each day, sanitiser is available to the students as is hand wash.

There is now a 'hands off' policy in the playground

Air Conditioners are being turned off, and windows are being open for more fresh air

More lessons are being held outside (where applicable)

Staff are modelling positive behaviour with the kids, and encouraging the children to be positive too

There is an additional playtime starting on March 19

All future events are POSTPONED at this time. Events are NOT cancelled. This includes the year 6 camp

It is important that the children are not overwhelmed, This is a strange time, and the school is staying as normal as is possible.
